We deeply appreciate your willingness to share your knowledge of your scholarship and creativity. Graduate and undergraduate student posters are encouraged.

**We are looking for posters that will:**

- Explicate recent or current research;
- Enhance the knowledge, skills, and self-care of those working in the field;
- Impart new information;
- Share promising strategies and effective practices, especially across the lifespan;
- Demonstrate innovative ideas/solutions.

**Review of proposals begins Friday, March 5, 2010:**

Using the poster proposal cover sheet, proposals must be typed or word processed and submitted in one of the following ways:

**Confirmation:**

No confirmation of receipt will be sent. If you require a confirmation, please include a self-addressed, stamped postcard bearing the title of the submission.

**Proposal Acceptance:**

If your poster is accepted, these guidelines will apply:

- Persons whose posters are accepted agree to participate at the time scheduled by the Convention Committee.
- Summary descriptive statement is what will be printed in the convention program materials.
- Notifications of acceptance will be e-mailed beginning in March, 2010. All correspondence will be sent via e-mail.
- Notification will be e-mailed to the author of the proposal only. The proposal author must notify other poster contributors.
- One easel will be provided for each poster presentation (posters must be pre-mounted — no materials will be provided onsite).

Please plan to adhere to the setup/tear-down instructions/timing included in the acceptance notification. Be prepared to respond to inquiries seeking further information on your topic. This could be in the form of handouts.

- Persons whose names are submitted must have given consent prior to being included.
- Participants who wish to attend any portion of the Annual Convention outside of the poster session must register and pay the registration fee.

**Attach a description statement, not to exceed 300 words, of the proposed poster.**

- Posters with a series of reports/research papers on a theme should give a brief summary of each paper.
- Posters offered previously in other settings should include a list of dates/locations offered.

**Attach a summary descriptive statement**, not to exceed 75 words typed, double spaced, which may be published in the Annual Convention program or in other brochures, publicizing your poster. This description should provide information as to content.
